Bruno D'Amore (born in Bologna, Italy) graduated in Mathematics, Philosophy and Pedagogy; PhD in Mathematics Education; PhD Honoris Causa from the University of Cyprus. Until 2010 he was full professor of Didactics of Mathematics at the University of Bologna; he has also taught at the Higher Pedagogical School in Locarno (Switzerland) and holds courses in various American and European Universities, Postgraduate and PhD programs. He collaborates in didactic research with many university institutes in various countries of the world. He founded in 1987 the trilingual international magazine *La matematica e la sua didattica*; he directss several book series for several Publishers. He is a member of the Scientific Committee of many important journals of Mathematics Education, published in various countries of the world (Italy, Cyprus, Slovakia, Greece, Mexico, Colombia, Switzerland, Peru, ...). He is the scientific director of the NRD (Group of Research in Mathematics Education) of the Department of Mathematics at the Bologna University (with funding from C.N.R. and MIUR), which himself founded in 1984. Founded in 1986 and is the Scientific Director of the National Meeting *Incontri con la Matematica* in Castel San Pietro Terme (Italy).

He has published more then 200 books (in various languages) and more then 800 articles in prestigious magazines from all over the world in various languages. Among these writings, some are closely related to the research in question. He has won numerous awards.

He currently collaborates with seminars and as a thesis director with the PhD in Educación Matemática of Distrital Francisco José de Caldas, Bogotá, Colombia.
