Martha Isabel Fandiño Pinilla was born in Pacho (Colombia) and holds Colombian and Italian citizenships. She graduated in "Science of Education with specific study in Mathematics" (National Pedagogical University of Bogotá); specialised in "Mathematics Education" (District University of Bogotá, Francisco José de Caldas); PhD in "Mathematics Education" (University of Nitra, Slovakia). She first taught in Primary School, then in High School and finally in the National Pedagogical University and the District University of Bogotá, especially in post-graduate courses for the training of Mathematics teachers.

She has taught courses as a lecturer in Italy at the University of Bologna (until 2015), the University of Urbino and the University of Bolzano (Brixen seat); in Switzerland at the University School of Locarno; in Colombia in postgraduate Master courses at the Universities of Medellin, Tunja, Manizales and others; she gives seminars and is a collaborator in the evaluation of doctoral theses in Educación Matemática at the University Distrital of Bogotá. She is or has often been a member of doctoral thesis tribunals in Colombia (Distrital University, Universidad Nacional), Spain, Italy etc.

She has been a consultant to the Ministry of National Education in Colombia for the Programme for the Evaluation and Qualification of Mathematics Teachers; she has been a member of the Italian National Evaluation Commission Invalsi; she has taught courses for ministerial inspectors on behalf of the Italian Ministry of University and Research (MIUR).

He has held training courses in Mathematics Education for teachers at all school levels, conferences and research seminars at national and international conferences in various countries in Europe and Latin America.

He has directed several didactic research groups on behalf of universities, educational institutions and Italian publishing houses.

She has been the scientific director of 27 national and 2 international conferences; we would like to mention the following scientific codirections: from 2004 to 2020 conference *Incontri con la Matematica (Meetings with the Mathematics)*, annual, with printed proceedings, held every year in November in Castel San Pietro Terme (Bologna); (2) from 2017 to present conference *Non temiAMO la matematica (We do not fear mathematics)* held in Ravarino (Modena); International Conference: *Didáctica de la matemática. Una mirada epistemológica y empírica (Mathematics Education. An epistemological and empirical view)*, Santa Marta (Colombia), 9-11 September 2015, organised on behalf of the Universidad de La Sabana, Chia, Colombia.

She has edited 3 book series on behalf of Italian publishers. She was an editorial consultant for a major Italian publishing house for a decade.

He is on the scientific committees of 10 research journals in different countries, in Europe and Latin America.

He has 326 written works to his credit to date; these include 51 books in various languages and 275 articles (research and popularisation), many of them published in prestigious journals, in various languages.

He carries out an intense research activity in topics related to the learning of mathematics within the NRD of the Department of Mathematics of the University of Bologna.

In 2013 he received the *Mención de honor al mérito pedagógico e investigativo y a la producción intelectual (Honourable mention for pedagogical and research merit and intellectual production)* from the Redipe (Red Iberoamericana de Pedagogía) in Cali (Colombia).
